**Rampage Sport Fishing Yachts Debuts New 34 Express IPS with Sport Fish Mode at Annual Dealer Meeting**

**Oconto, Wis. (Aug. 11, 2008)** – Rampage Sport Fishing Yachts made waves at its 2009 worldwide dealer meeting with the debut of its new Rampage 34 Express powered by the Volvo Penta IPS technology with sport fish mode. Dozens of Rampage dealers from around the world, as well as journalists from national top tier fishing and boating publications, had the chance to sea trial the 34 Express prototype IPS model on the open waters of Lake Michigan. This year’s meeting was held at the Blue Harbor Resort and Convention Center in Sheboygan, Wisconsin.

The Rampage 34 Express with IPS and sport fish mode is proving to be outstanding in both performance and maneuverability. The revolutionary new propulsion system dramatically increases power and is more fuel efficient than conventional inboard models. Tony Martens, director of Product Development and Engineering for Rampage Sport Fishing Yachts, has spent countless hours making sure this new technology will give the new Rampage 34 Express a ride like no other.

“With the Volvo Penta system you’re going to get better range. This means you’ll get better performance and better maneuverability, so the boat should run faster than a conventional inboard with the same size engine,” said Martens.

The Rampage 34 Express contains many of the features from the Rampage 33 Express that owners have come to love, with the added kick of IPS and sport fish mode. The exceptional bow flare, a sharp entry, and a full 13’ beam are all standard on the 34. This model, as well as the other 2009 Rampage Sport Fishing Yachts models, will be available in Rampage’s new arctic white color. Production of the Rampage 34 Express is not scheduled until later this year.
